

*Government Notice No. 231 of 2021*

**THE MAURITIUS FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICE ACT**

**Regulations made by the Minister under sections 18, 19 and 27  
of the Mauritius Fire and Rescue Service Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Mauritius Fire and Rescue Service (Fire Safety Plan and Fire Certificate) (Amendment) Regulations 2021.
2. In these regulations –  
“principal regulations” means the Mauritius Fire and Rescue Service (Fire Safety Plan and Fire Certificate) Regulations 2018.
3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following new definition, the full stop at the end of the definition of “Act” being deleted and replaced by a semicolon –  
“National Electronic Licensing System” means the National Electronic Licensing System referred to in section 27A of the Economic Development Board Act.
4. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the following regulation –
  5. (1) For the purpose of section 19 of the Act, an application for a fire certificate or for the renewal of a fire certificate shall be made to the Chief Fire Officer through the National Electronic Licensing System or in such other manner as the Chief Fire Officer may determine.
  - (2) (a) Subject to paragraph (b), where the Chief Fire Officer grants an application, a fire certificate shall be issued on payment of the appropriate fee specified in the Third Schedule.

(b) Where the Chief Fire Officer grants an application for a fire certificate made before 13 September 2021, other than for the renewal of a fire certificate, a fire certificate shall be issued on payment of the appropriate fee specified in the revoked Third Schedule.

5. The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
6. The Fourth and Fifth Schedules to the principal regulations are revoked.
7. These regulations shall come into operation on 13 September 2021.

1. Application fee for fire certificate	Nil
2. Reinspection fee	1,000
3. For the issue of fire certificate or renewal of fire certificate –	
(a) where the area of the premises does not exceed 1,000 m <sup>2</sup>	1,000
(b) for every additional 1,000 m <sup>2</sup> or part thereof	1,000
(c) up to maximum fee	25,000
4. Approval of fire safety plan	1,000
